



## Driving Environmental Social & Governance Excellence

Oman Liquefied Natural Gas (Oman LNG) presents its second annual Sustainability Report, which covers the company's Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) performance for the 2023 calendar year. This report provides an overview of our efforts and progress in sustainability areas that are most important to our organisation and stakeholders.

Drive Operational Excellence: We reached a remarkable production milestone of 11.5 million metric tonnes, exceeding the plant's enhanced production capacity for the second year in a row. Moreover, the reliability of our LNG trains stands at 95%, alongside a plant utilisation rate of 92%. To continue advancing, we have launched a multi-year transformation that aims to increase LNG supply reliability, reduce resource usage, minimise GHG emissions, and ensure employee safety. Additionally, We continue to invest in safety, achieving 21 million manhours and 43.34 million kilometers driven without any recorded Lost Time Injuries (LTI).

Minimise Environmental Impacts: Aligned with the national Net-Zero Emissions Strategy, we continue to make progress towards our goal of achieving net-zero emissions from our internal operations by 2050. We demonstrated our commitment by signing the Oil & Gas Methane Partnership's Global Methane Pledge. By joining, we agree to take voluntary actions to contribute to the collective effort to reduce global methane emissions by at least 30% from 2020 levels by 2030. Additionally, we had the great honour to participate and support representation of the Sultanate of Oman's Pavilion at the UN Climate Change Conference (COP28), highlighting Oman's efforts in combating climate change, supporting environmental preservation, and leading the energy transition.

Put People First: Our people are key to our success. We invest in their growth and maintain an inclusive culture where all employees have equitable opportunities to thrive. In 2023, we were pleased to see gender diversity in our workforce increasing, at all layers of the organisation. We also take pride in maintaining an impressive Omanisation rate of over 90% among our workforce through a rigorous staff development and knowledge transfer program. We were pleased to see that 80% of Oman LNG employees who took part in our 2023 People Survey felt that their team leader encourages open dialogue and understands how to align and engage the team to create an outstanding work environment.

**Create Shared Value:** Oman LNG strives to create positive societal development and shared value for all stakeholders. We remain committed to contributing 1.5% of the company's net income after tax to social investment programmes aligned with community needs. In 2023, through the Oman LNG Development Foundation (ODF), we supported local initiatives including the inauguration of the Road Safety Institute in Sur, the Sultanate of Oman's first National Autism Centre in Muscat, and the rehabilitation of Mibam Sustainable Village, the first of its kind in the Sultanate. Additionally, we sustained our pledge to foster In Country Value (ICV) as demonstrated by our site-based business partners, which have a 73% Omanisation rate overall and a 55% Omanisation rate in supervisory roles. Furthermore, 87% of our supply chain spend was with locally registered companies.





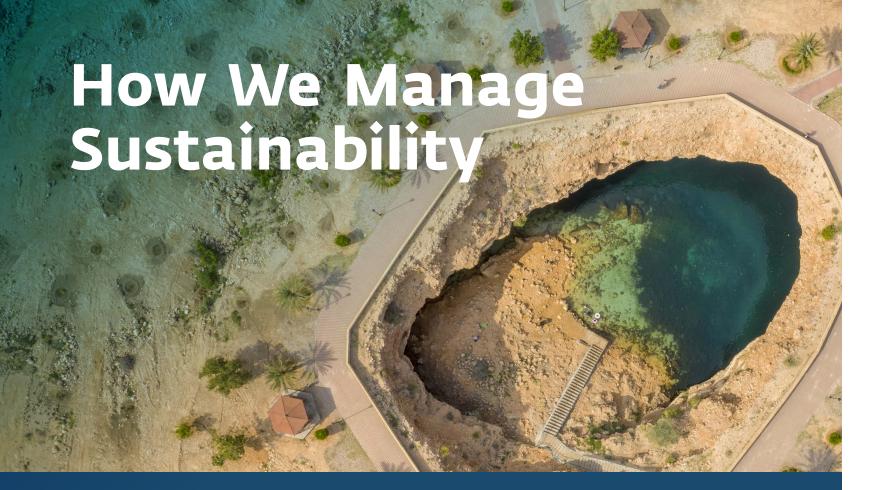

In 2023, we continued to build on and integrate our framework throughout our businesses, while developing our approach towards sustainability management.



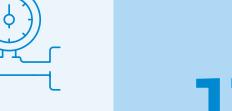

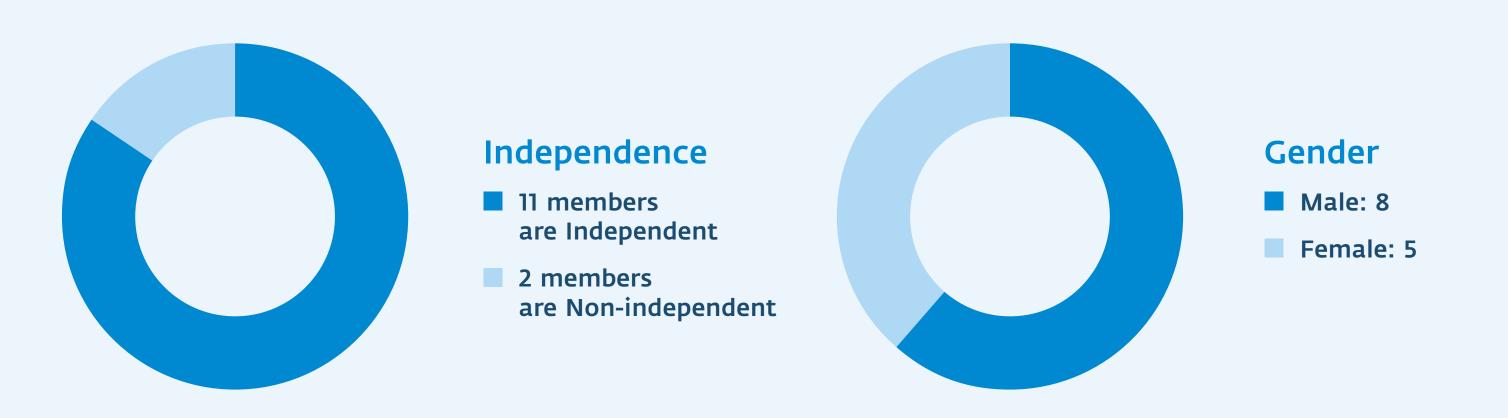


**Introduced an e-service tool** to improve real-time tracking of compliance-related activities and collaboration between teams on compliance related projects.
