

ROAD SAFETY POLICY

OBJECTIVE

The aim of this policy is to manage the risks of driving and the transportation of people and goods on Company Business.

SCOPE

This policy applies to:

- All company staff, contractors, subcontractors, suppliers' vehicles and drivers on company business; and
- Contracts exceeding three months, which cover vehicles, drivers, or common carriers used exclusively by OMAN LNG.

This policy does not apply to:

- Bicycles and non-motorized vehicles;
- Commuting;

POLICY

- It is mandatory to follow Oman's road traffic rules at all times.
- It is mandatory to possess a valid Omani driving license.
- It is mandatory to adhere to Oman LNG's Journey Management procedure.
- It is not allowed to use a mobile phone (hands free or handheld) while driving.
- It is the driver's responsibility to ensure the vehicle is in good technical and roadworthy condition.
- Drivers shall attend and pass a defensive driving training course in order to drive company owned vehicles. A period of 3 months grace is allowed for this activity.
- It is mandatory to wear seatbelts by the driver and all passengers (including in buses).
- Driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited.
- It is mandatory to comply with Oman LNG Road Safety Procedure NG-P005.
- Ensure strict adherence to advice issued by the Company on weather conditions

DRIVING ON BUSINESS TRIPS OUTSIDE OMAN, DRIVERS SHALL

- Ensure full insurance coverage within the countries to be visited.
- Familiarise themselves and adhere to the applicable road traffic rules before driving.
- Possess a valid driving license recognized by the host countries.
- Pay particular attention to fatigue management after extended flights.
